## Epping Relocation Update



An opportunity presented for Epping Surgery Centre to purchase the neighbouring property at 32 Boronia Avenue and a revised DA has now been submitted to Council for the combined properties – 32 & 34 Boronia Avenue. The day surgery is now located over one level in a single-story building. This design further provides greater set back and landscaping, lessening the bulk and scale and improving the amenity of the day surgery into the local neighbourhood.

The plans provide a single storey house-like structure with the incorporation of a modern, high-tech day surgery centre. Once approval is granted, building works will commence.
